

Report from BMU GA 2024.

The BMU 24, GA meeting took place in Paklenica National park - Croatia. Organized and hosted by the Croatian mountaineering association.

May 10th, 2024. Paklenica - Croatia

The session of the BMU General Assembly was chaired by the member of the BMU Executive Board, Martin Šolar, instead of the BMU president Dragoslav Gogić, who was justifiably absent. After the welcome, the report from the previous BMU General Assembly was unanimously adopted. The president of the Croatian Mountaineering Association Darko Berljak addressed the participants of the session and spoke about the jubilee, 150 years of the Croatian Mountaineering Association. An 8-minute documentary film about the history and work of the Croatian Mountaineering Association was also shown.

The president of EUMA, Josef Klenner, also addressed the audience, stressing that regional cooperation is extremely important. ERA president Boris Mičić also spoke at the session, who emphasized that it is very important for EUMA, ERA and BMU to work together. After the welcome speeches, a quorum was established. Representatives of the Turkish and Greek Mountaineering Association did not participate in the work of the session.

The representative of the Mountaineering Association of Serbia, Nenad Lečić, submitted a report from the Balkan Championship in Mountaineering, which was held in 2023 on Mount Zlatibor. The president of the Mountaineering Association of North Macedonia, Zoran Chitkushev, spoke about this year's competition, which will be held in North Macedonia, in Delčevo, from October 11 to 13, 2024.

The rules for the mountain running competition were also presented at the meeting, which was unanimously adopted after discussion.

There was no proposal to organize an expedition.

The host of the next BMU session, in 2025, is the Mountaineering Association of Slovenia, and in 2026, the Mountaineering Association of Serbia will be the host.
